Internships at Camp Twin Lakes can offer many opportunities for leadership and personal growth, often surpassing the choices available at local agencies. If your college or university requires you to complete an internship program as part of your graduation requirements, let us know. We can help you design a summer experience that will meet your needs for academic credit and service learning.

We can provide an experience that applies to a variety of majors, including Psychology, Child and Family Development, Recreation, Education, Counseling, Communications, and many others. We can help you design a supervised learning opportunity that fits your interests and satisfies your school's requirements. We will work closely with you and your advisor to provide appropriate feedback and evaluations.

All students working on an internship are considered full staff members and are paid a stipend. This could be one of the greatest possibilities for you, where we provide income, as well as room and board in contrast to most unpaid internships. There are three available tracks for a camp internship: Summer, Fall or Spring.

- Summer Interns will work daily with program implementation with children.
- The Fall and Spring options are geared more toward planning for the summer, and working with family and weekend programs while learning more about the internal workings of Camp Twin Lakes and our partner agencies.

This program consists of leadership and professional development, staff recruiting, program design, program enhancement, planning, and more.
