**Camp Twin Lakes Receives The Imlay Foundation's Largest Single Grant in History  
*Grant Funds State-of-the-Art Swimming Pool for Kids with Serious Illnesses, Disabilities and Challenges***

**ATLANTA, GA (March 14, 2011)** – Camp Twin Lakes recently announced that it is the recipient of the single largest grant in The Imlay Foundation's history. This generous grant enables Camp Twin Lakes to build a new, state-of-the-art swimming pool at its Rutledge, Georgia, campus.

Camp Twin Lakes continues to grow and last year partnered with over fifty organizations to bring 8,000 campers to its camps. Camp Twin Lakes Executive Director, Eric M. Its gift enables us to construct a new pool at our campsite in Rutledge featuring the latest safety, access and filtration technology for serving our campers who have serious illnesses, disabilities and other life challenges."

Prior to making their decision, The Imlay Foundation board and family members visited Camp Twin Lakes' Rutledge campus during a camp session and were captivated by the organization and its programs. "We are privileged to work with Camp Twin Lakes on this signature project that is integral to its summer program," commented John Imlay, Chairman of The Imlay Foundation Board of Directors. "Many of these campers would not have an opportunity to experience camp without Camp Twin Lakes. We are excited to be a part of this enhanced camp experience."

In conjunction with the addition of the new swimming pool, Camp Twin Lakes is proud to have received six new aquatic wheelchairs to support its accessible swimming program. The Fragile Kids Foundation donated one aquatic wheelchair and Kids II provided a grant to purchase an additional five aquatic wheelchairs.
